BYLAW NO. 380, 2011.

Being a bylaw to establish municipal election procedures.

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Local Government Act*, Council may, by bylaw, establish procedures for municipal elections;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Radium Hot Springs, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as "Election Procedure Bylaw No. 380, 2011."
2. For the purposes of all elections and other voting, a person may register as an elector only at the time of voting. Registration as an elector is effective only for the voting or other matters on which the opinion of the electors is being sought at the time of voting.
3. The minimum number of qualified nominators required to make a nomination for office as a member of Council shall be 5.
4. Nominations for mayor, or councillor, must be accompanied by a nomination deposit in the amount of \$100.00.
5. A single advance voting opportunity shall be held which shall be ten days prior to the general voting day.
6. Voting and registration may be done by mail for those electors who meet the following criteria for each election or other voting:
 - (i) those persons who have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting opportunity;
 - (ii) persons who expect to be absent from the Village of Radium Hot Springs on general voting day and at the advance voting opportunity.
7. The time limits in relation to voting by mail ballot will be determined by the Chief Election Officer. A mail ballot must be received by the Chief Election Officer before the close of voting on general voting day in order to be counted for an election.
8. In the event of a tie vote after a judicial recount, the tie vote will be resolved by conducting a lot in accordance with section 141 of the Local Government Act.
9. The Village of Radium Hot Springs Bylaws No. 81, 1993 and No. 260, 2002 are hereby repealed.

OCP amendment Bylaw 381
Zoning amendment Bylaw 382

Schickedanz Properties BC Ltd. has submitted an application for an OCP and Zoning amendment for Lot 1 located on Ridge Road in North Radium.

The proposed amendments would down zone the property from Pedestrian Commercial Residential to Multiple Family Residential. The applicant has indicated that due to the changed market conditions since the property was originally zoned Commercial Residential in 2003, that they feel it is more appropriate to rezone to Multiple Family Residential.

This down zoning, if approved, will have an adverse effect on taxation rates as the mill rates would reduce from commercial to residential. The overall impact to the Village tax revenue is approximately \$4250.00 based on 2011 tax rates.

These OCP/Zoning bylaw amendments will require a public hearing. With the statutory advertising and notice requirements, the earliest a public hearing could be held is September 14th. This is a regular Council meeting night.

As per the *Local Government Act*, Sec 890(5): "More than one bylaw may be included in one notice of public hearing, and more than one bylaw may be considered at a public hearing."

Being a bylaw to amend the Official Community Plan Bylaw.

WHEREAS Section 875, and 876 of the Local Government Act provide that municipalities may adopt Official Community Plans so as to guide decisions on planning and land use management, and;

WHEREAS Section 895 provides that these guidelines may be amended.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Radium Hot Springs in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. That the Planned Land Use Map 'Schedule A' of the Village of Radium Hot Springs Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 254, 2002 be amended by changing the land use designation on the portion of property shown outlined in heavy black on Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw from "Mixed Commercial/Residential" to "Multi Family Residential"
2. This Bylaw may be cited as "Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 381, 2011".

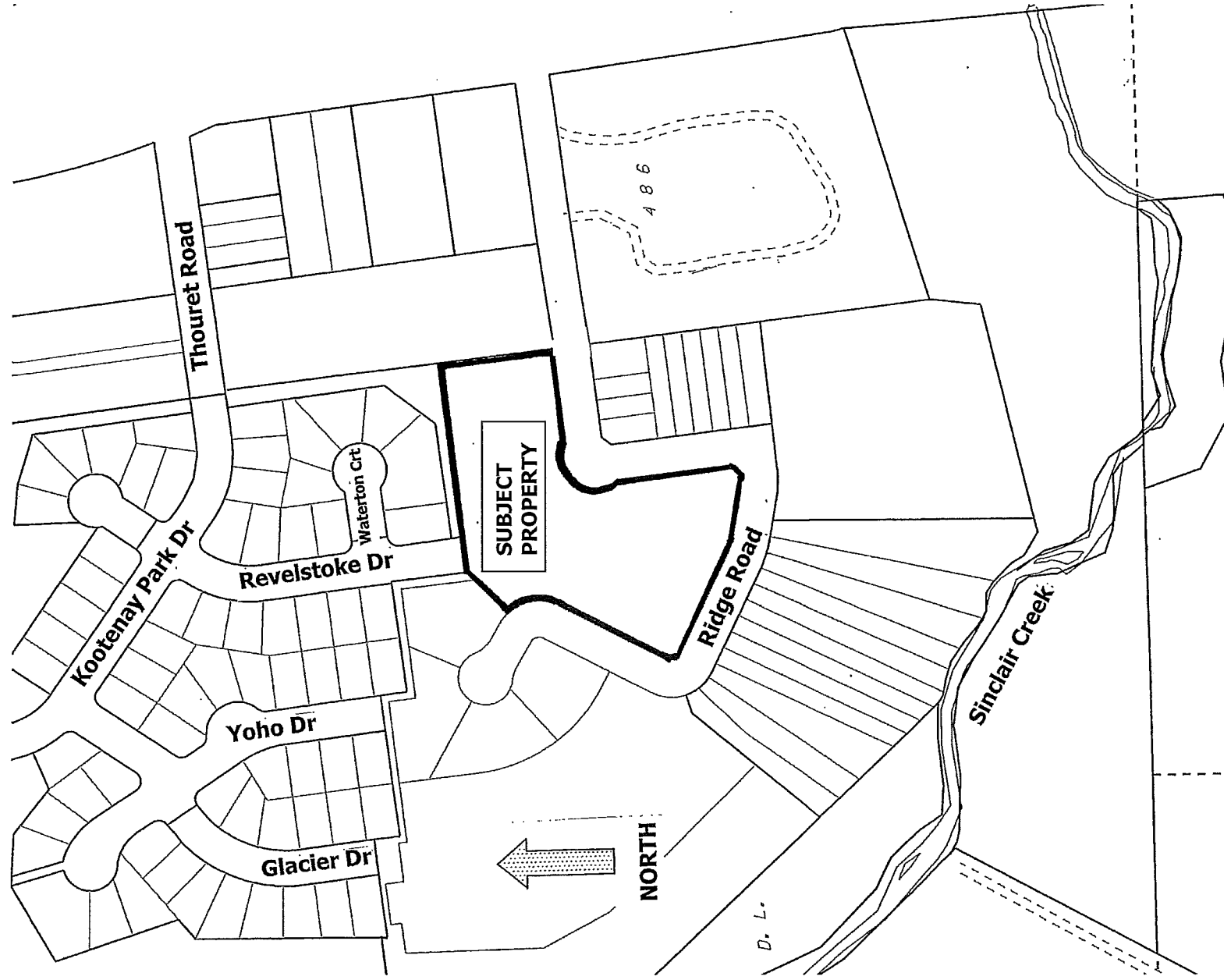

Schedule A – Bylaw 381, 2011

VILLAGE OF RADIUM HOT SPRINGS

BYLAW 382, 2011.

Being a bylaw to amend the zoning bylaw.

WHEREAS Section 903 of the *Local Government Act* provides that a local government may, by bylaw, divide the whole or part of the municipality into zones; regulate the use of land, building and structures within a zone; regulate the siting, size and dimensions of buildings; regulate the location of uses on the land and within buildings and structures; and that the regulations may be different for different uses within a zone;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to amend the zoning bylaw, cited as “Village of Radium Hot Springs Zoning Bylaw No. 338, 2007” to change lands from **C2 ‘Pedestrian Commercial Residential’** to **R3 ‘Multiple Family Residential’**.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Radium Hot Springs in open meeting assembled *enacts* that the Village of Radium Hot Springs Zoning Bylaw No. 338, 2007 is hereby amended as follows:

- 1) That Schedule “B”, Official Zoning Map referenced to in section 5.2 of the Village of Radium Hot Springs Zoning Bylaw No. 338, 2007 is hereby amended with the zoning area changes shown on Schedule “A” attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
- 2) This amendment changes the zoning for:
 - 1. Lot 1, District Lot 486, Kootenay District Plan, NEP77300.
- 3) This Bylaw may be cited as “Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 382, 2011.

That this bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon passage.

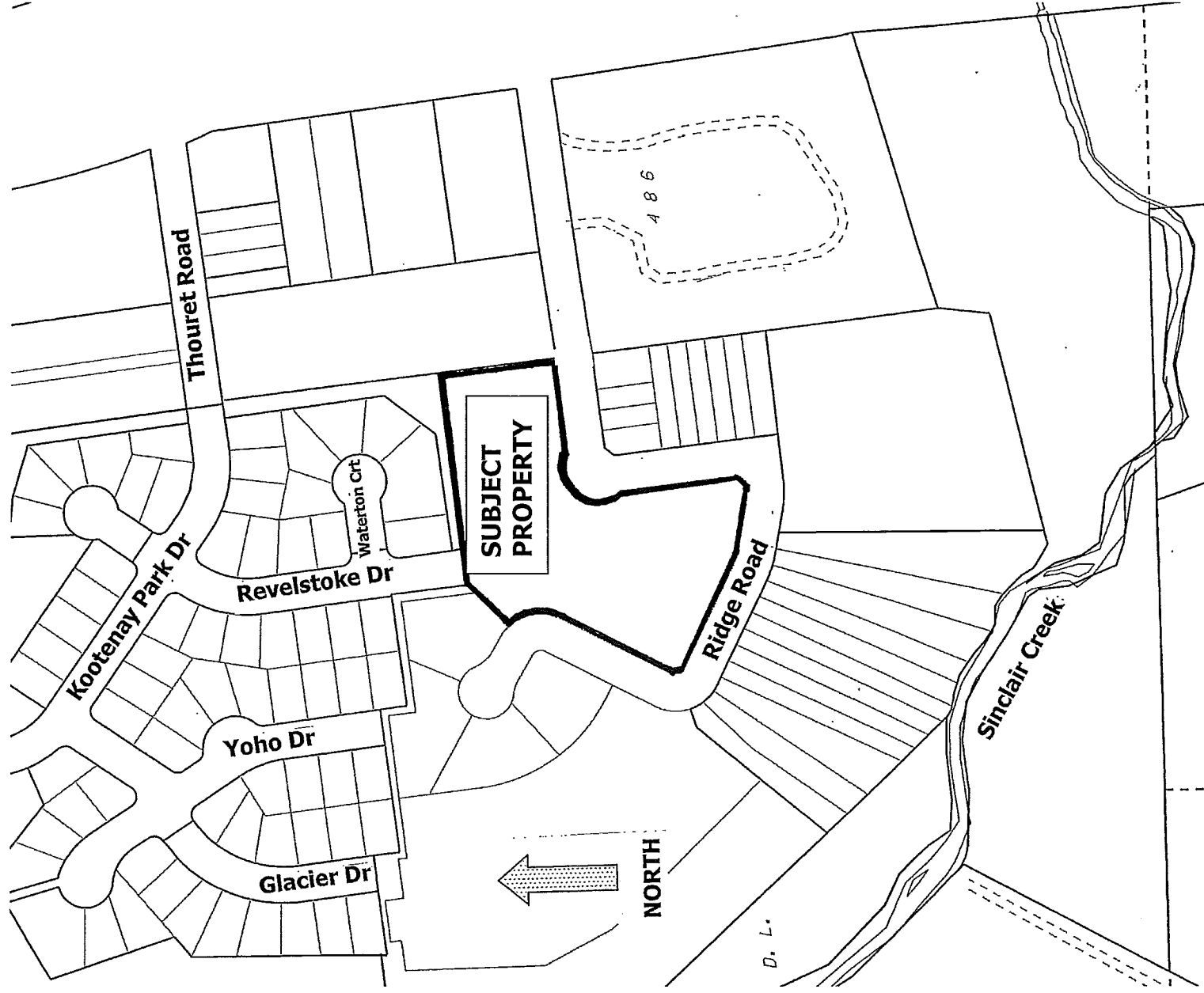

Bylaw 383, Building Bylaw amendment

Partially due to the economic downturn over the last few years, there are a number of Building Permits on file which have expired. Currently, in our existing Building Regulation bylaw, a Building Permit is active for a period of 2 years. The bylaw also allows for the permit to be extended once for a period of 1 year only.

Several of the building permits have already had the 1 year extension, and the current bylaw does not have a mechanism to extend any further, therefore the permit lapses.

This proposed bylaw amendment removes the 1 year extension and provides a fee schedule for the re-issue of a new building permit.

The BC Building Code is updated on a regular basis, and only the Building Code in place at the time of permit issue can be used to regulate the construction of a building or structure. Therefore, building permits which are several years old would be inspected based on potentially old standards. As an example, some of the new standards which have come in during the last couple of years include: increased insulation values, increased window standards, low flush bathroom fixtures, etc. By issuing a new permit for a partially completed structure, we will be able to enforce the increased standards on the portion of the building or structure remaining to be completed.

Cost of re-issuing a building permit is proposed to be the greater of \$100 or 25% of the original permit value. This proposed rate is consistent with other jurisdictions in the Kootenays.

BYLAW 383, 2011

Being a bylaw to amend the Building Regulation Bylaw

WHEREAS Section 8(3)(1) of the Community Charter provides that a local government may, by bylaw; regulate, prohibit and impose requirements in relation to buildings and other structures;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to amend the building bylaw, cited as “Building Regulation Bylaw 204, 2000”, to change renewal conditions and fees;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Radium Hot Springs in open meeting assembled *enacts* that the Village of Radium Hot Springs Building Regulation Bylaw No. 204, 2000 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Permit Conditions, Section 14.8 is Repealed;
2. Permit Conditions, Section 14.9 is Added;
 - 14.9 A lapsed permit may be reissued for a twelve month period for an additional fee as set out in Schedule “A”. Any changes to the BC Building Code since the date of issuance of the original permit may be incorporated into the re-issued permit. A permit may be re-issued for subsequent twelve month periods subject to payment of permit re-issue fees set out in Schedule “A”;
3. Schedule A – Building and Plumbing Permit Fees Section 8 is Repealed;
4. Schedule A – Building and Plumbing Permit Fees Section 12 is Added;
 - 12 Building Permit Re-issue Greater of \$100 or 25% of the original permit value;
5. This Bylaw may be cited as ‘Building Regulation Amendment Bylaw No.383, 2011.

That this bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon passage.

Being a by-law to provide for a permissive exemption from taxation of lands held by a religious organization and used for purposes of public worship.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Radium Hot Springs in open meeting, assembled **ENACTS** as follows:

1) The following land and improvements shall be exempt from municipal taxes for the 2012 taxation year:

The Roman Catholic Bishop of Nelson.

The Roman Catholic Bishop of Nelson.

Folio #03760.040 PID# 027-729-796
Lot 4, Plan NEP87941, District Lot 2580, Kootenay Land District,
The Roman Catholic Bishop of Nelson.

Lot 5, Plan NEP87941, District Lot 2580, Kootenay Land District,
The Roman Catholic Bishop of Nelson.

2) This permissive exemption shall include the entire lot for each property noted above. Currently the properties, held in the name of Roman Catholic Bishop of Nelson, are used for a church, church parking and 'Stations of the Cross'.

3) This by-law shall be cited as "Tax Exemption (Church Properties) By-law No. 384, 2011".

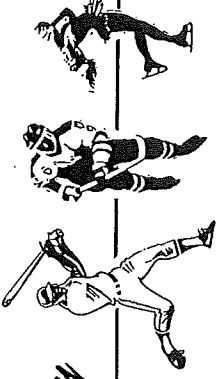

Each year the municipality is responsible to collect taxes on behalf of other parties – provincial government – school tax & police tax, regional district (RDEK) and hospital taxes (KERDH); and collect levies from other organizations – Municipal Finance Authority (MFA) and BC Assessment Authority (BCAA).

The school and police taxes collected are paid to the Minister of Finance based on a specific schedule whereas the other funds collected are due by the end of July. Below is a summary of the payments made to the various organizations for the purpose of forwarding the funds collected their behalf:
